



## The ABC's of the P.R.I.D.E. Program at West Rockhill

Ask your child what was learned in school each day. **B**e sure your child attends school on a regular basis. **C**ontact the school whenever your child is absent or whenever you have a concern. **D**o go over the school rules with your child.

Encourage your child to follow the school rules. **F**oster a love of reading by reading to your child daily. **G**o over your child's schoolwork and check your child's folder each night. **H**ave an area to display your child's work. **I**ncrease your child's self-esteem with positive comments. **J**oin the Parent/Teacher Organization. **K**eep in contact with your child's teacher. **L**isten to your child's concerns and interests.

**M**odel respect, kindness, and courtesy for your child. **N**otify the school if there are any changes in address, medication, etc. **O**rganize your child's materials each night. **P**ractise good manners with your child. **Q**uestion your child about school

each day. **R**ead the school handbook and other notes that come home. **S**et a special time aside each night for your child to do homework. **T**alk to your child's teacher if there is a concern. **U**nderstand that all children are unique and special.

Visit the school on parent conference days, during visitation week, and for special events. **W**e, the staff of West Rockhill Elementary School, **eX**pect your child to (P) Be POLITE, (R) Be RESPONSIBLE, (I) INCLUDE Others, (D) DEMONSTRATE Safety, (E) Show EMPATHY in their school and home communities at all times in order to help make learning "E-Z" for all!
